What is included in the Hapag-Lloyd container specification booklet?

This container specification booklet provides guidance on the main technical data for Hapag-Lloyd containers, with a focus on dimensions, weights and design features. What is a seafold 40 HC container?

SeaFold 40' has the same features as a conventional 40' HC container. Requires no special handling or maintenance equipment. Safe and easy folding and erecting procedure. Compatible with all standard lift equipment found in most ports and terminals. Serviceable by existing maintenance organizations and depots throughout the world.

What is a "named cargo container"?

DIN EN ISO of January 1996 specifies under Code S and group code SN "named cargo containers". Examples of these include containers for transporting livestock (type code S0), containers for transporting automobiles (type code S1) and containers for transporting live fish (type code S2).

Do Hapag-Lloyd 40' containers have a gooseneck tunnel?

All Hapag-Lloyd 40' containers are fitted with a gooseneck tunnel to enable transport on a gooseneck chassis. Exposed timber is treated according to Australian, European, Chinese and American requirements. Containers display the ISO size type code. For further information please see page 50.
