Who will build a solar PV plant in Cote d'Ivoire?

Abidjan, Cote d'Ivoire, August 7th, 2025 - IFC and the Government of Cote d'Ivoire today announced Infinity Power Holding as the winning bidder to design, finance, build, and operate two grid-connected solar PV plants in Cote d'Ivoire.

Will Cote d'Ivoire have a solar power plant?

The solar power plant is then expected to be the largest in West Africa. The further expansion of solar energy in Cote d'Ivoire will primarily be realised by private investors. The successful project in Boundiali demonstrates to them that large solar projects are technically and financially feasible in similar countries.

Where is the first solar power plant in Cote d'Ivoire?

In Boundiali in the north of Cote d'Ivoire, the country's first solar power plant has now been inaugurated by Ivorian Prime Minister Beugre; Mamboury; and German Parliamentary State Secretary Babel Kofler. The power plant has already been providing up to 37 megawatts of power since June 2023.

When will a solar power plant open in Cote d'Ivoire?

In the northern region of the Cote d'Ivoire, the first phase of a solar power facility has been officially opened. The Boundiali solar power plant's financing was initially revealed in 2018, and details of its commissioning were made public in December 2022.
