How big is Ireland's solar capacity in 2024?

Ireland's solar capacity hit a remarkable 1.76 GW in 2024, a 160% annual increase. Explore the key projects, production stats, and future renewable energy goals.

How much solar energy does Ireland have?

Ireland has achieved a significant milestone in solar energy development, with its installed capacity reaching an impressive 1.76 GW as of July 1, 2024. According to the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), this marks an extraordinary 160% increase from the previous year.

How many solar projects are there in Ireland?

Over 400 MW of utility-scale ground-mounted solar was added in 2024, taking the total for operational capacity in the Republic of Ireland (ROI) to over 1 GW. Ireland continues to see a strong focus on large-scale solar, with four projects over 130 MW operational.

Which energy storage companies are working in Ireland?

Statkraft delivered the first energy storage project in Ireland with Fluence in 2020, at its Kilathmoy wind farm, and the company has continued to have a strong presence in the Irish energy storage field since then. The company is also lining up another milestone project soon, with the country's first four-hour duration energy storage system.
